JOURNALING IS ESSENTIAL TO EFFECTIVELY ENGAGING WITH GOD'S WORD.

JOURNALING HELPS YOU FOCUS

When moving from reading to journaling through the Bible, you will begin to see real benefits in your ability to **focus** while you read. Journaling through the Bible will help you see key themes, consider how they apply to you, learn to discern God's voice as he speaks to you, and consider how God wants you to respond to what you've learned.

JOURNALING IS A GREAT WAY TO SHARE WHAT YOU'RE LEARNING

Your journal is very helpful when you're having conversations with others about what the Lord has been saying to you as you read. As God grows your faith through your reading and journaling, you'll have key takeaways that you can weave into conversations with your co-workers, friends, family, or connect group.

JOURNALING CREATES A RECORD OF GOD'S GRACE AND PROVISION

The best time to start journaling through the Bible was ten years ago. The second-best time is today. As you build the habit of journaling through scripture, you'll have a written journey of how God has been working in your life.

Journaling promotes reading the Bible with a life-transforming purpose. No longer will your focus be on just finishing the reading; your new and deeper purpose will now be to read so that you can **hear God's voice** and **respond** in obedience.

HOW TO USE YOUR JOURNAL

Pray - Before you start reading, pray something like this: Lord, forgive me for my sin and cleanse my heart. *Fill me with your Spirit and help me to focus and hear your voice. And now, Lord, "Open my eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of your law."* (Psalm 119:18)

Read - and as you read, highlight a few verses that seem to stand out to you. Learn to trust that this is the Lord speaking to you through his Spirit. Then, you can use your journal like this:

1. **SCRIPTURE** – in your journal, *write* out the 2-3 verses that you highlighted. Trust that this is the Lord speaking to you.
2. **HEAR God's voice** – as you listen, jot down what you hear God saying through the verses you highlighted. It takes practice, but keep at it as you learn to discern God's voice as you read. **He wants to speak to you through his Word!** John 10:27 says "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me."
3. **OBEY God's instruction** – jot down what you need to do to be obedient to what God is telling you. John 14:15 says "*If you love me, you will keep my commandments.*"
4. **TELL a friend** – who do you know who might need this word of encouragement today? Ask the Lord to place someone on your heart and to give you an opportunity to share this encouraging word with them this week. Mark 16:15 says "And he said to them, "*Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation.*"

FROM "BETWEEN THE CROSS AND THE THRONE:
THE BOOK OF REVELATION"
BY MATT EMMERSON (USED WITH PERMISSION)

In most Christian circles, the book of Revelation is either wildly popular or completely avoided. [But] this book is neither a decoder ring for the end times, nor an avoidable, weird addition tacked on to the biblical canon. Rather, it is a book that was and is vital for the Church; it assures us, even as we face tribulation, of the triune God's victorious reign and the imminence of Christ's return.

Today, many Christians avoid John's vision of the end of all things, most likely because of his consistent use of unfamiliar imagery and figurative language. Most of us, especially modern Western Christians, are simply not familiar with this type of literature. Our unfamiliarity with the Old Testament—from which John draws most of his imagery—coupled with modernity's focus on the objective and scientific, makes it difficult to grasp what John is doing in Revelation.

To interpret Revelation we need to engage it as John wrote it—figuratively and symbolically. Recognizing John's use of symbols and images does not negate the book's truthfulness—far from it. Instead, Revelation describes reality using word pictures, and so our job as readers is to reorient our imaginations—our beliefs about the world and its powers—through understanding and appropriating John's vision in our own day.

When we are faced with the threat of martyrdom, the prospect of economic ruin, or even ridicule for our Christian faith from the larger culture, Revelation reminds us that, in spite of the uncomfortable or even dire nature of our present circumstances, the good and sovereign Trinitarian God is working all things together for good for those who love him.

FROM THE NIV INTRODUCTION TO REVELATION:

John's vision has four main parts, each marked by the phrase "in the Spirit." After words of warning and encouragement to each of the seven churches, John's visions then center on Jesus—his role in redemption and the judgments he brings to the world. The immoral political and economic forces that rebel against God will be destroyed, and the Messiah will triumph over all his enemies. The vision closes with the promise that God's faithful servants will reign over the new creation. Amen!

Sermon Title

All laws in the bible, even those that don't apply to us today, reveal something about the law-giver. So while this book can APPEAR to be just a listing of weird (seriously weird!) laws and practices, what it does is reveal the heart of God, what he values. So as you read it, don't look so much for immediate application each day, but for insight into who God is and what it takes to be able to experience him in his holiness.

Often viewed as a dense collection of laws and rituals, Leviticus is central to understanding God's covenant with Israel and the foundations of holiness in the Bible. As the third book of the Torah, Leviticus outlines the sacrificial system, priestly duties, and laws related to purity that governed Israel's relationship with God. While its detailed regulations may seem distant from modern life, Leviticus provides a powerful backdrop for the work of Christ and the New Testament understanding of sacrifice, atonement, and holiness.

Additionally, Leviticus teaches profound lessons about worship, community, and justice. It emphasizes the importance of approaching God with reverence and the call for believers to be set apart, echoing Peter's exhortation to be holy as God is holy (1 Peter 1:16). By studying Leviticus, Christians today can gain a deeper appreciation of God's redemptive plan and how the Old Testament laws find their completion in Christ.

This book is not just a long list of laws and rituals, but a story about God's desire to repair his relationship with Israel, so they can live with him in a restored holy space and rest with him as reformed people who represent his character to all the nations.

For Christians, reading Leviticus is essential to grasp the depth of Jesus' sacrifice on the cross. The intricate details of offerings, the Day of Atonement, and the laws concerning sin and purity foreshadow the ultimate, once-for-all atonement made by Jesus. Leviticus highlights God's holiness and humanity's need for cleansing, which is perfectly fulfilled in Christ. Halleluiah!
