## BIBLE READING AND JOURNALING MAKES A POWERFUL AND POSITIVE IMPACT ON OUR LIVES.



Daily reading God's Word and journaling holds great value. A recent scientific study by the Center for Bible Engagement indicated that Christians who are engaged in daily Bible reading have a significant decrease in negative habits or behaviors, and, according to the report, "Controlling for other factors, those who read or listen to the Bible at least four days a week have much higher odds of participating in these behaviors:

- Sharing faith with others = 228% higher odds
- Discipling others = 231% higher odds
- Memorizing Scripture = 407% higher odds."

## HOW TO USE YOUR JOURNAL

**Pray** - Before you start reading, pray something like this: *Lord, forgive me for my sin and cleanse my heart. Fill me with your Spirit and help me to focus and hear your voice. And now, Lord, "Open my eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of your law."* (Psalm 119:18)

**Read** - and as you read, highlight a few verses that seem to stand out to you. Learn to trust that this is the Lord speaking to you through his Spirit. Then, you can use your journal like this:

1. **SCRIPTURE** – in your journal, write out the 2-3 verses that you highlighted. Trust that this is the Lord speaking to you.
2. **HEAR God's voice** – as you listen, jot down what you hear God saying through the verses you highlighted. **He wants to speak to you through his Word!** John 10:27 says *"My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me."*
3. **OBEY God's instruction** – jot down what you need to do to be obedient to what God is telling you. John 14:15 says *"If you love me, you will keep my commandments."*
4. **TELL a friend** – who do you know who might need this word of encouragement today? Mark 16:15 says *"And he said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation."*

## **PALM SUNDAY, 04/13/25**

ZECHARIAH 9:9-17; MATTHEW 21:1-11

HE WOULD ANNOUNCE HIMSELF PUBLICLY AS THE MESSIAH  
BY RIDING A LOWLY DONKEY INTO JERUSALEM.

At first glance this looks like the biggest celebration Jerusalem had ever seen. No doubt, it was an incredible day, enough to cause quite a stir among the enemies of Jesus. But think about it. What the people desired was a mock procession of a conquering king. Philip Yancey, in *The Jesus I Never Knew*, imagines a Roman soldier riding up to check out the disturbance. He had seen processions done right. The conquering general sits in a chariot of gold, with stallions straining at the reins and wheel spikes flashing in the sunlight. Following him would be officers in polished armor displaying the banners from the vanquished armies. Following that was often a procession of captured slaves and prisoners in chains, showing just what Rome does to those who are against her.

Most of us have the mental picture of Jesus as the Good Shepherd with a baby lamb on His shoulders, carrying it to safety. We think of the soft images of Jesus in the manger as a baby or as a grown up with children sitting in His lap. But there's one picture few of us ponder very often. It's the picture of Jesus on the Monday before His death storming through the temple like a wild man yelling at people to leave! In one of the most dramatic acts of His ministry, Jesus said more about the priority of prayer than in a hundred sermons on the subject. He actually did this twice in His ministry and the first time He made a whip out of cords and was thrashing people out of the temple.

On Monday, before He cleansed the temple, Jesus cursed a fig tree. On Tuesday, the disciples saw the result. At first glance, this is one of the strangest things Jesus ever did, but it carries deep spiritual meaning. In the Old Testament, fig trees were used as a symbol for Israel. When Jesus saw a fig tree full of leaves but without fruit, it pointed to Israel's outward religious activity (like temple worship, sacrifices, and legalism) but a lack of true faith and righteousness. The tree looked healthy but bore no fruit. Is it possible to appear devoted to Jesus but lack a true spiritual life?

On the night before His death, Jesus would teach the greatest lessons of His ministry to His disciples. The Master-teacher would use object lessons, symbols, and hands-on teaching to make His point. The first lesson was on servanthood; the second was on sacrifice. Jesus took off his robe and wrapped it around His waste, looking like a slave boy. He then got on His knees and washed of His disciples' dirty feet - an act performed only by a servant, not a master. When He finished, He didn't say, "Now that I've washed your feet, you wash mine". Instead, He said, "Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you wash one another's feet" (John 13:14). You see, the way we express love to Jesus is by expressing love to one another. The way we serve Him is by serving others.

It's interesting that on the final week of Jesus' life He spoke much about His return. It should come as no surprise. The scenario is pretty simple as He explains it in John 14. "Don't worry. I'm leaving for a while, but I'll be back. And when I come back, I'll take you with me." The return of Christ is certain. His return is final. And when He comes again, He will separate those who are with Him from those who are not. Separation is a sad thing. Jesus knew a lot about separation. He was about to experience a separation such as He had never known before. When He cried out, "My God, my God, why have You forsaken Me?", He was experiencing a sense of abandonment of His Father. Jesus experienced what it was like to feel abandoned, as He took on our sin upon Himself. And He did it all for you and me, so that we would never be abandoned. He did it all so that one day, He could come back and take us home. He was about to be united with the Father again, as He was before His incarnation. Soon the weary traveler from a foreign land would find Himself in the loving arms of His Father. That's the same reunion He wants you to know as well. When He comes again, every person who ever lived will be judged based on what he/she did with the gift of His salvation. He's coming back for you. Who will you bring with you?



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**FRIDAY, 04/18/25**

We call it “Good Friday”. But like so many things in the Kingdom of God, it was good for us, but bad for Him. What we call “Good” was terrible for our Lord Jesus. As you go about your day today, consider these facts: Early on that Friday morning, after no sleep the night before, Jesus was taken to Pilate’s prison. He was beaten by professional torturers who knew their craft all too well. He was then presented to the crowd who chose the notorious prisoner over the very Son of God. Throughout the day Jesus was silent and, ironically, directing every move that took place. He was taken into the courtyard (called the Praetorium) and the entire company of soldiers surrounded Him. They stripped Him, put a crown of thorns on His head, a staff in His hand, and knelt down before Him in mockery. They spat on Him and punched Him many times, as hard as they could. Later that morning, exhausted and famished, He carried His own cross to Golgotha and was nailed to it at about 9:00am. Darkness came over the earth from noon until 3:00 p.m. Not much later that afternoon, Jesus cried out “It is finished!” and He died. Around 5:00 or 6:00 p.m. the women came to prepare His body for burial, and they placed it in the tomb. The massive stone was rolled into place as the sun went down on the saddest day in history. And the angels were silent as all creation watched to see what would happen next.
