

MOMCO KIDS INFORMATION

Dear Moms,

We are so excited for your child/children to be joining MomCo Kids! The goal of MomCo Kids is to help your children learn about God through His Word. It is a great place to make friends and have a lot of fun! Your child will be assigned to a classroom based on their birthday, so they will be with other kids their age. Their teachers are professional childcare workers who have special lessons planned each week to help them learn more about God! Below are a few reminders to help your children have the best experience possible!

- Please try to drop off on time. We understand that this is not always possible, but the closer we stay to the scheduled drop off time the easier it is for your child and the other kids in the room to start having fun! Drop off is from 9:00–9:30 a.m.
- When you drop off and pick up your children, please knock on the door and wait for the teacher to greet you. Please do not go into the classroom, as this keeps everyone safe and minimizes disruptions for other children.
- Please fill out an instruction card (located outside of each classroom) and give it to the teacher when you drop your child off. You can put your cell phone number and any helpful instructions for the morning.
- It is easier for both the children and the teacher if you leave quickly with a kiss and a hug. The teacher will find you if your children need you.
- Please keep your children at home if they are not feeling well or have a runny nose, bad cough, rash, skin infection, communicable disease or have a bad fever, diarrhea or vomiting within the past 24 hours.
- Please clearly label everything that belongs to your child. This helps the teachers keep track of everything for all children.
- Please bring enough disposable diapers for the morning (no cloth diapers in the nursery, please).
- Please pack an extra change of clothes in case of an accident.
- There are many toys to play with in each classroom. Please leave special toys at home so they do not accidentally get lost.
- If your child is an infant, please bring bottles of milk or formula so the teachers can feed your baby while you are away. You are also welcome to nurse your child in our private nursing room (the teachers can show you where this is located).
- Please do not pack a lunch, as the children will be provided a snack and water in the morning.
- Please tell the teachers if your child has a serious allergy or feeding problem. Please also list it on the sign in card.
